- ONLY hard woods can be burned in the lodge. No Pine Logs may be burned in wood stoves.
- Garbage is your responsibility. You must take away your own garbage. Dumpster only available May to October 31st.
- The lodge is not equipped with cooking utensils or any pots and pans. You must bring your own.
