This letter of agreement is for the purpose of establishing the use of Columbia-Montour Council's Camp Lavigne, specifically the Project Cope and Climbing areas. I, the requestor, agree to provide the Columbia-Montour Council/Program Manager (PM) with the following documents:

- a. a certificate of liability insurance with a minimum of \$1 million CSL (combined single limit) insured (For non-BSA groups only) provided as soon as possible following request.
- b. a signed and completed hold-harmless agreement form (copy attached) for each participant by day of visit.

I, the requestor, agree that our group will be held responsible for any and all damages to camp property that may be reasonably attributed to the actions of the said group and agrees to properly pay any and all reasonable damage claims when presented. I understand I am obligated to report such damages prior to our departure from camp.

I, the requestor, agree that I will provide at least one adult (****defined as 21 years of age or older**) for the entire visit. BSA groups must have two. I also understand that the adult assigned must be present with the group at all times while the group is in camp.

I, the requestor, agree that, FOR SAFETY REASONS, our group will abide by any and all of the camp operating rules, the Project COPE and Climbing area rules, and any instructions or directions given by the director, all instructors present, and the camp ranger.

I, the requestor, agree that our group will be held responsible for any meals needed, for the participants only, and to be properly dressed for the elements and the areas visiting. I understand all equipment will be provided but that we may use our own gear (helmet and harness ONLY) following an intense inspection and final approval by the area director. Any questions call the PM.

I understand that while the Boy Scouts of America organization makes every effort to accommodate persons with disabilities, it is a charitable, private organization not subject to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and any group that uses the property is responsible for ADA compliance and any accommodations necessary for participants and visitors.

I understand that Camp Lavigne is a smoke free facility. I also understand that absolutely NO alcoholic beverages or drugs, illegal or synthetic, or weapons of any kind are permitted on camp property, nor will any of our participants be under the influence of the above mentioned substances. I also understand the BSA is obligated to report any and all illegal activities to the local authorities.

I understand that your instructor corps is highly trained and experienced in providing a safe and quality program. However, SAFETY IS FIRST AND FOREMOST the most important factor during our visit and that our group, as well as your director and all instructors present, must act accordingly and with the maturity needed to successfully, and SAFELY, navigate the courses offered. Failure, by one or both parties, to follow any of the above terms, or by the committing an unsafe act, will result in the immediate termination of the activity and the removal of the offender(s), or the entire group if necessary, from camp property indefinitely.
